ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Funen Art Academy offers admission at two levels

Basic module: 1 - 3 study year
 Higher module: 4 - 5 study year

1. Admission to the basic module:

Admission to the basic module at Funen Art Academy is based on a professional artistic evaluation of the submitted work examples as well as an interview with the selected applicants. No specific prior education is required, but the student is expected to speak and read English.

2. Admission to the higher module:

It is a precondition for admission to the higher module that you have completed a 3-year artistic education at a higher level at an art academy, art college or similar institution. It is expected that the student is able to speak and read English.

Application Form:

Please submit your application via the online application system, Slideroom. Your application must be uploaded via Slideroom before the admission deadline April 28. Funen Art Academy will accept no further applications once the deadline has passed.

Once you have registered and created an account to start an application via Slideroom, you may return to your application and make further edits up until the final deadline. Please make sure to save your edits each time you log on and do not submit until you are 100% sure that you have properly uploaded the required components outlined below. Once you click submit, you may no longer edit your application.

The following three components are required to successfully complete your application:

- A) Motivational letter
- B) Work documentation
- C) Payment of application fee

A) Motivational letter - maximum 3000 characters (approx. 500 words).

The motivational letter is your chance to describe why you are applying to art school. Please outline why you are interested in Funen Art Academy's study program and how you imagine our Basic and Advanced Module to be relevant of your interests, past experience and work.

B) Work documentation:

Applicants must submit work documentation for 5 projects with a maximum of 3 files a piece. Please provide title, date, materials, and dimensions for each image/file uploaded. Maximum duration for moving image files is 3 minutes. Instructions about appropriate file types are provided during the uploading process in Slideroom.

NB: Applicants to the higher module can also choose to submit documentation of sketches, model proposals or works in progress.

C) Application fee: DKK 550,-

Confirmation:

A confirmation notification will appear once Slideroom has received your application. It is not possible to make changes to your application after submission. Funen Art Academy will not accept any further material by e-mail or regular mail.

Interviews:

Based on the submitted work documentation, selected applicants will be invited for an interview at Funen Art Academy. Please note that you may be asked to bring the original pieces.

For those invited for an interview, interviews will take place on June 1. The interview invitations will be sent out via e-mail.

Each applicant will be informed about the result as soon as possible. Notification takes place via e-mail. Please note that we do not answer enquiries about results over the phone or in person.
