

Articles of Association for Student Council at Funen Art Academy

Name

§1 The name of the association is: Student Council

Base

§2 Student Council has its base at Funen Art Academy.

Purpose

§3 Student Council represents the students at Funen Art Academy and has the task of working for the benefits of the student body, as well as caretaking the interests of all students on the academy. Including to strengthen the collaboration of the students by social and educational arrangements.

§4 Student Council has the task of representing all the students of the academy towards the administration, various councils and organs as well as employees.

§5 All the students of Funen Art Academy has democratic rights in Student Council.

§6 Student Council is not affected by party-political interests.

The Structure of Student Council

§7 Student Council meets up once a month. This meeting is open for all students at funen art academy, and the students can beforehand suggest topics for discussion at these meetings.

§8 Outsiders (including teachers and the principal) are only allowed to participate through invitation and/or vote.

§9 A summary should be made at every meeting. The members of Student Council will take turns doing this.

§10 It is the responsibility of the front persons to save the summaries as well as other relevant material related to the work of Student Council.

§11 The front person and the vice front person has the responsibility of caretaking the ongoing dialogue with the management of the academy.

§12 Student Council can at any time create subcommittees if there is a need for it.

Votings

§13 When voting in the Student Council or at great meetings, decisions are made by simple majority. A vote can be a show of hands as well as a gathering of ballot papers or an online poll, depending on the circumstances and what the given vote is about.

§14 All votes on choice of representatives and trust votes will be in writing.

§15 Votes can not be given by the power of attorney.

General Assembly

§16 The general assembly is the highest decision organ in Student Council.

§17 General assembly will be held once a year. The general assembly must take place during the first quarter of the calendar year.

§18 Every student at Funen Art Academy has the possibility to participate and vote at the general assembly and it has to be visible to everyone that it is being held. Summoning for the ordinary general assembly must happen at least three weeks before being held.

§19 The agenda is sent out at least one week before the general assembly. Points wished for the agenda must be in the hands of Student Council at least one day before the general assembly.

§20 At the general assembly minimum one front person and gladly also a vice front person are selected.

§21 The ordinary general assembly must as a minimum contain following agenda:

1. Election of moderator, referent and vote-counter
2. The the front persons' report of the year past, as well as the approval of this
3. Election of front person and vice front person
4. Approval of the financial account
5. Received suggestions
6. Eventualities

Extraordinary General Assembly

§22 A summon of an extraordinary general assembly must happen at least a week in advance. The agenda is sent out together with the summon.

§23 Every student can summon an extraordinary general assembly via inquiry to Student Council.

Great Meetings

§24 By great meetings all students are summoned. Student Council decides whether and when there is a need for a great meeting. Every student can always via Student Council summon for such a meeting.

§25 A representative from Student Council summons for the meeting with at least one weeks notice, where also an agenda for the meeting will be sent out.

§26 Points for the agenda of the meeting must be sent to Student Council at least one week before the meeting.

§27 A summary will be made at every great meeting

Changes of Articles of Association

§28 Changes in these articles of association must be adopted at an ordinary or extraordinary general assembly by simple majority.

Disruption

§29 Disruption of the organisation must be adopted based on two general assemblies. These can be ordinary and/or extraordinary and here, simple majority is applied. At least one month must have passed between these two general assemblies.
