Questions about admission:

Question: When can I apply?

Answer: All deadlines will appear on FAA's website: www.funenartacademy.dk

Question: When does the school year begin and end?

Answer: The school year begins on 1 September and consists of one autumn semester and one spring semester. The autumn semester runs from 1 September to 31 January. The spring semester runs from 1 February to 30 June. There is no teaching between 30 June and 1 September.

Question: How do I apply?

Answer: Applications must be submitted through a digital application system. Procedure for this will be published on FAA's website:
www.funenartacademy.dk

Question: When will I receive an admission decision?

Answer: You will be notified of whether you have been invited to interview by the end of May at the latest. If you are invited to interview, you will be notified of whether you have been accepted within five business days after the interview.

Question: When is admission?

Answer: Admission will take place during spring. Dates will appear on FAA's website.

Question: Are there any costs in connection to my application?

Answer: There is an application fee of 600 DKK.
This covers admission costs, and is non-refundable.

Question: If I don't live in Denmark, should I still travel to Denmark, if I get an interview for admission?

Answer: In some cases the interview can take place over Teams.

Question: Do I need a specific educational background or previous knowledge to apply to FAA?

Answer: There are no set requirements regarding secondary or higher education, when applying for FAA's Basic Module.

Question: Can I apply for admission, even though I do not live in the EU?

Answer: Yes, you are welcome to apply for admission even if you do not live in the EU.

Questions about the teaching:

Question: When does teaching take place?

Answer: The school year begins on 1 September. The programme is a full-time study programme, and teaching generally takes place Monday to Friday between 9:00 and 17:00. The Basic Module corresponds to 180 credits, equivalent to 3 years of full-time study. The Advanced Module corresponds to 120 credits, equivalent to 5 years of full-time study. A credit describes the workload of one week of study as 25-30 hours, including preparation, teaching, lectures, seminars, self-study and studio work. Credits follow ECTS standards.

Question: When does the semester begin?

Answer: The semester starts September 1st.

Question: Can I get SU during my education?

Answer: Yes, you are entitled to SU during the education, if you meet the requirements. Read more: <http://www.su.dk/english>

Question: Is the programme taught in Danish or English?

Answer: The main language of instruction is Danish. When needed a workshop and a practice group will be offered in English each semester, allowing non-Danish-speaking students to obtain the 30 ECTS credits required to complete a full semester.
Art History and Art Theory in Basic Module, both of which are compulsory

courses, are taught in Danish.

Question: Does it cost anything to attend Funen Art Academy?

Answer: No, it does not cost anything to go to the Academy.

Questions about Funen Art Academy:

Question: Where is Funen Art Academy?

Answer: Jernbanegade 13, 5000 Odense C, Denmark

Question: What is Funen Art Academy?

Answer: Funen Art Academy is a higher education institution offering a long-cycle higher education programme in visual arts.

Question: What is the education equivalent to?

Answer: As a graduate, you will be awarded a diploma.

However, since Funen Art Academy is not accredited, graduates do not obtain an official bachelor's or master's degree.

Question: What is the average age of the students at Funen Art Academy?

Answer: The average age of students is between 19 and 25 years, but there are no age restrictions.
